For all the dogs & Hoomans welfare and safety
please read and take heed...

Please keep all dogs on leads in all parts of the dog show and fete area for the duration of the Dog Show and fete inc. set up and set down!

The * 'Person in Charge' of the dog at the time of the fete is responsible for controlling their dogs behaviour in public.

- A person in charge must not have more than 3 dogs in their care unless they are licensed to have up to 4 dogs and are publicly displaying that licence.
- All dogs to be **kept on leads** in all parts of the fete and dog show area & to be held by someone able to *properly control the dog for the duration of the fete and Dog Show.
- All dogs must wear a collar and ID tag when out in public, which must detail their owner's name and address, including postcode.
- Dogs that are required to **wear muzzles** in public either by law or because they may have a high prey drive or eat things, are welcome but must comply with these T&Cs and wearing a correctly fitted muzzle.
- **Dogs with anxiety** – any dog, regardless of age, who is anxious is welcome but please do consider the stress you are putting them under by attending the fete or the dog show which is highly populated and may affect their wellbeing and / or overstimulate them.
- **Cleaning up after your dog** – Royston field is covered by a Public Space Protection Order (PSPO). These can be used to make sure dogs are kept under control (see below) as well as to require dog owners to clean up after their pets in public areas.
- **All entrants must register** and pay for each of the categories they wish to enter their dogs into in advance of the competition categories being entered for or before the closing time of 1:30 pm – no late entrants can be accepted.
- Each category is limited to a max of 16 entries.
- **No bitches in season are allowed on site.** This is to deter unnecessary anxiety for all parties.
- Owners of dogs not displaying a calm manner will be asked to withdraw from the dog show.
- **No dogs under 4 months old** are permitted to enter the dog show – but they are welcome to come and socialise. This is to minimise potential anxiety in a young dog

Hydration and the heat

Please consider the weather and what suits your dog. Keep your dog in the shade as much as possible before the dog show. There is limited shade at the fete and the arena is not under a tree canopy. We will minimise the time spent in the arena and have shade at the entrance.

Fresh water for dogs will be available at the dog show registration desk and at the arena – but do bring your own supply too.

* "Proper Control" means a dog being on a lead or muzzled if the dog requires it, or otherwise being at heel/close enough to the person in charge that it can be restrained if necessary or responding immediately to voice commands.
